

## HOW TO LOCATE YOUR VELUX CODE

Examples of different data plates found on VELUX windows & the information that we need to assist you.

Note; ID plates differ depending on the age/model of your VELUX window. Find your type below to see where you can locate the right details for your product. To locate your code details please follow the below guide;



### Centre-Pivot Window | GGL/GGU

Open the window using the ventilation bar at the top of the sash, and bring the sash down to eye level so that you are looking at the top edge. The code is located on a data plate on the left hand side.

(right hand side pre V22).

### Top-Hung Window | GPL/GPU/GHL/GHU

Open the window using the handle at the bottom of the sash but do not push the sash outwards. Open the window in the centre-pivot facility using the ventilation bar at the top of the sash, and bring the sash down to eye level so that you are looking at the top edge. The code is located on a data plate on the left hand side.

(right hand side pre V22).



### Vertical Window | VFE/VIU

Open the window using the centre handle at the top of the sash.  
Allow the window to open fully (instructions can be found on the window installation instruction). The code is located on the external left edge of the sash.



### Fixed Additional Element | GIL/GIU

The code is located on the underside of the internal top edge of the sash.



### CABRIO | GDL

Open the window using the handle at the bottom of the sash but do not push the sash outwards. Open the window in the centre-pivot facility using the ventilation bar at the top of the sash, and bring the sash down to eye level so that you are looking at the top edge.  
The code is located on a data plate on the left hand side (right hand side pre V22). The bottom window code can be found by opening the top window first, and then pushing the bottom element open.  
The code is located on the exterior right hand edge of the sash, located behind the spindles.



### Flat Roof Window | CFP/CVP

The code is located on the inner edge of the frame, in the bottom lower corner of one side.



### Roof Terrace | GEL

Open the top window in the top-hung function. Open the bottom window, and the code can be found on the exterior edge of the sash on the same side as the handle.



### Conservation Window | GVA/GVT

If you have a conservation roof light, the code will be located on a silver coloured aluminium plated located on the inside of the opening sash or black polyurethane frame.


### Flat Roof Window | CFP/CVP

The code is located on the inner edge of the frame, in the bottom lower corner of one side.



### Sun Tunnels | All variants

Older non-K variants (010/014) – Remove the trimming around the ceiling diffuser. The product code will then be located on the edge of the diffuser, underneath the trimming.

Newer K variants (OK14/014) – Remove the ceiling diffuser.

The product code will be found in the inside of the diffuser housing.
